

# Galgo Homes Wanted!



## Poster Activity Guide

**If you have been learning about Galgos then you will know how important it is to find them homes where they can be looked after and loved as part of a family.**

Use this activity with younger children to create 'WANTED' posters for family homes for our rescued galgos. Older children can create campaign posters to raise awareness of the plight of the galgo, and to help stop galgos being ill-treated and abandoned.


You will need:

- 1 x poster template for each child\*
- Old magazines/newspapers (optional)
- Galgo images/characters (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured pencils

1. Discuss the purpose of a wanted/campaign poster. Explain that the poster needs to be eye-catching and attention grabbing as well as informative.
2. Introduce children to the template they will be using. Remind them of the key messages to help them think about the captions, slogans, and information they will need to include on their poster.
3. Brainstorm key vocabulary and discuss or model, as appropriate, using imperative verbs to give orders, commands, warnings, or instructions.
4. Provide each child with a poster template and access to coloured pens/pencils and other resources to help design and complete their posters.
5. Where possible, provide access to old newspapers and magazines, scissors and glue. Encourage children to find and cut out the letters they need to make their 'WANTED' headline stand out, together with other words and letters to create their main slogan in either English or Spanish.
6. Children use the central box to draw and/or cut and stick an appropriate galgo image or character.
7. Finally, they complete their poster with any other information required to help others understand the message.
8. Display the posters and peer evaluate for visual impact and clarity of information.
